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### **Budget Highlights**

The McGowan Labor Government is delivering for people in Murray-Wellington and across WA, including:

- **\$400 Electricity Credit for every WA household** bringing total power bill assistance over three years to **\$1,400**.
- **\$2.7 billion** in new investment in **health and mental health** backing in our record spending.
- **\$750 million** in extra funding to boost housing and land supply and address homelessness.
- **3** \$2.4 million to complete the **Waroona Town Centre Revitalisation project**.

## **Cost of Living**



- We're giving every WA household a \$400 Electricity Credit and \$826 for those most in need.
- We're also giving a \$650 Electricity Credit to eligible small businesses.
- We stopped Liberal-National plans to privatise our energy assets, meaning we've avoided spiralling power prices and allowed us to provide energy bill relief for families.
- We're increasing the Cost of Living
  Rebate for WA Seniors Card members.
- We're now at 97 per cent of our goal to deliver 125,000 new jobs by 2025-26, two years ahead of schedule putting WA Jobs first.
- We're funding a \$2,000 training completion payment for housing construction apprentices and up to \$500 worth of tool and safety equipment rebates.
- We're delivering \$2.5 million to increase the travel and accommodation allowance for WA apprentices and trainees who are required to travel long distances off-the-job for their training.



# Housing



- Our \$750 million boost to housing supply and choice will get more Western Australians into affordable homes.
- This includes \$450 million extra for the Social Housing Investment Fund meaning 4,000 homes will be built with 1,200 already delivered.
- We're also boosting the Government Regional Officer Housing budget by \$61.6 million building extra homes, refurbishing existing homes and freezing GROH rents to support the public sector workforce in the regions.
- We're committed to the regions which is why we're allocating a **further \$4 billion** in spending to the **Royalties for Regions** program over the next four years.
- We're funding \$11.2 billion of infrastructure investment in regional WA - and only 9 per cent of that is Royalties for Region funding, which means we're making substantial extra investments in our regions.
- Whether it's funding for cost of living relief, health, housing or specific regional initiatives like agriculture and national parks we're supporting regional WA.



#### Health



- We're investing a further \$2.7 billion in WA health and mental health bringing our new investment to an unprecedented \$10 billion over the last three years.
- An additional \$75 million is being spent to address ED pressures and ambulance ramping, bringing the total spend on ED specific initiatives to over \$452 million in this term of government.
- Despite global health workforce shortages, we've increased our health workforce by 22% over three years - and we're going to help pay off HECS-HELP loans for new nurses in WA regions.





- We're further funding **Operation Regional Shield** by **\$11.7 million**,

  securing frontline police resources in

  communities dealing with youth crime.
- Our \$400 Seniors Security Rebate is proving popular, with over \$7 million being spent on security systems and CCTV, helping keep our seniors safe.
- We're providing \$24.4 million to bolster the Department of Fire and Emergency Services natural disaster recovery team.
